Short Report:

Getting into automobiles always created a strange feeling for Ms. G. Even if the car was just parked, she felt uncomfortable and unsafe. God brought her to Life of Freedom Ministries, and we spent some time discerning the root of her troubles. In the process of ministry, she shared that she had a sibling who died by suicide in a car. When she presented the matter to God in prayer, she confessed her hurt

and anger over the events. She broke any curses that demons claimed to use to be with her. She did this for herself and for her family for the traumatic event of her sibling's death. We addressed the spirits connected to this issue, and they admitted they no longer had a right to be with her. They were cast out immediately. From that point on, she no longer had trouble being in an automobile! This was not the only problem that she addressed, as God worked powerfully in bringing Ms. G healing. Step by step, she found freedom and peace in the Lord Jesus Christ.

Something to Consider:

1 John 3:8b—*The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work.*

Hebrews 2:14-15—¹⁴*Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil—*¹⁵*and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death.*

In Matthew's account of the birth of Jesus, in Matthew 1:23, he quotes the prophet Isaiah, noting that Jesus fulfilled the promise of a son named Immanuel—God with us (Isaiah 7:14). We celebrate the Incarnation of the Word of God this time of year. The focus is often on how the Lord Jesus came to save us by dying on the cross for our sins. In a ministry that daily deals with evil spirits, I see the coming of the Savior as much, much greater than just dying for our sins. I am not in any way trying to minimize what He has done for us in regard to bringing us forgiveness of sins by dying on the cross. Instead, I'm sharing that His coming was even more!

The invasion of enemy occupied territory by Jesus was done to destroy the hold that the devil and his host had on us. It is absolutely incredible to me that God accomplished this through Jesus being born as a baby! Certainly, the powers of darkness wanted to take Him out, and tried to do so when prompting Herod to kill all of the boys age two and younger. Even as a baby, He was a threat to them! Nonetheless, Jesus Christ was born and grew to be a man who died on Calvary's cross and destroyed the devil's work. I, therefore, encourage you to consider this Christmas as a celebration of God's invasion into the enemy's territory, where He then won the victory over them. May you be blessed with the assurance of the victory of the Lord Jesus!
