In a month where we celebrate freedom in the United States, it is quite fitting to think of freedom that only the Lord gives. We can be very thankful for the freedom that He gives, as without Him, there is no hope of deliverance from the powers of darkness. I believe we should not take our freedom lightly. Galatians 5:13 notes that we are not to use our freedom for selfish, fleshly living, but instead to be loving servants of others. The Short Report for this month notes how God desires us to be free and live by His power. The client desired to serve the Lord Jesus, but was hindered to do so because of the afflicting work of evil spirits. After the dark spirits were evicted, she increased her service with a joy and love for others. Instead of cruising through life with the freedom she had in Christ, she chose to share His love with others. I encourage you to also share His love and help to bring to others the freedom and healing that only Jesus can give.

Praises:

I give praise to God for His healing work in a wounded young man who was greatly abused by his parents.

I give praise to God for His bringing freedom to a woman who had curses put on her by her own family, which allowed spirits to torment her with horrific dreams.

I praise God for His healing and deliverance of a client who was personally and ancestrally involved in magic healing.

Short Report:

When a person is abused, especially sexually, it is common for that person to make vow of some sort to try and overcome the pain. Ms. UU did just that by vowing to not feel the pain. The problem was the pain was bubbling up in the rest of life. She was just not happy with life, and felt stuck. She confessed to God the sin done against her of sexual abuse, and cancelled the soul tie created by the sexual contact. Even though she did not want the sexual activity, the persons are still tied together. She also confessed to God the sins of her own life and ancestry. We then confronted the spirits. When addressing them, the demons made her feel funny, which isn't unusual. It can actually be helpful for the certainty that an outside entity is at work in the person's life. For Ms. UU, the sensation was greater than for most of my clients. Over the course of a number of sessions, we encountered and cast out a number of spirits. Some were inherited, some were transferred from the abuser, and some were personal. Lust, Envy, Greed, Confusion, Sexual sins, Selfish, Rebellion, Disrespect, Guilt, Shame, Confusion, Unforgiveness, False Joy, Impatience, Defeat, Disappointment, Resentment, Disrespect, Judgment, Denial, Perfectionism, Rigidity, Double Standard, Dishonesty, and more. The spirits took advantage of the original hurt of sexual abuse and then from that platform attacked her mind and emotions to create even more strongholds. All of these function names the spirits held were at work to create inner turmoil in her and problems in her life. They all were cast out in Jesus' name and Ms. UU grew in serving and living for the Lord Jesus.

Something to Consider:

Isaiah 53:5—⁵ *But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.*

Matthew 8:1-2—*When Jesus came down from the mountainside, large crowds followed him. ² A man with leprosy came and knelt before him and said, “Lord, if you are willing, you can make me clean.”*

I have been amazed at how many Christians who have experiences like Ms. UU have believed that the struggles are “just life,” or it is deserved. The person often assumes it is their cross to carry, and that they should just “deal with it.” Ms. UU originally thought that was the case with her. Therefore, she tried with all of her own might to overcome and not allow the pain to hinder her in living for the Lord Jesus. She vowed it would not hurt anymore. Instead of victory, there was only a downward path of greater trouble. Looking at the list of evil spirits that afflicted her, we can see they had her on an emotional roller coaster. She had to work hard to be perfect, and yet felt guilty for not doing enough. The critical attitude she’d have toward herself was then directed at others as well, as she’d be impatient and rigid. While denying the pain was present, it was very evident that it was. Certainly, it is understandable that she was confused! The confusion was of little help in her roles of serving others at her church, and even caused her to question if she should continue in the role.

Thankfully, Ms. UU chose to address the matter, and was healed of the emotional wound and set free from the spirits who were taking advantage of the wound. Just as Jesus was willing to heal the man in Matthew 8, He was willing to bring healing to Ms. UU. I have yet to experience in a ministry session where Jesus refused to minister emotional and spiritual healing to a person who humbly chose to specifically forgive others and specifically confess to God the personal and ancestral sins, as well as the sins done against the person. Physical healing did not always happen, but the peace of Christ comes upon them in some fashion as He heals the emotional and spiritual burdens. In some cases it is very dramatic. For others, it is subtle and the evidence is seen more in the changes of everyday life. He ministers to each person in a unique way that fits that person well. Ms. UU could serve God with confidence, knowing He truly did love and care for her.


Prayer Concerns:
